

VILLAGE OF MCADAM
BY – LAW NO. 11

A BY – LAW TO ESTABLISH A CURFEW

Passed November 14, 1967
BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor
And the Councilors of the Village of
McAdam as follows:

1. No child under the age of 16 years shall be in a public place in the Village after the hour of ten o'clock in the evening unless he or she is accompanied by an adult person of the age of 21 years or more.
2. (1) Any child under the age of sixteen years found in a public place after the hour of ten o'clock in the evening may be ordered by any peace officer or constable to go home.
(2) Where a child so ordered refuses or neglects to go home, such child may be:
 - (a) Taken to such place of shelter as the Mayor may designate as a children's shelter for the purpose of this by-law;
 - (b) Dealt with as a child in need of protection under the child welfare act.
3. Every parent, guardian or other person having the care, custody or control of any child who permits such child to violate this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and upon concoction shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$5.00 for the first offence and not exceeding \$10.00 for any subsequent offence.
4. The Fire Chief may at ten o'clock in the evening of every day cause to be sounded a horn or whistle.
