BY LAW NO. 30

A BY LAW RESPECTING REMUNERATION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILLORS

PASSED March 6, 1975
BE IN ENACTED by the Mayor
And Councillors of the Village of McAdam as follows:

1. (a) The Mayor shall be paid a salary of \$734 per annum.
(b) Each councillor shall be paid a salary of \$434 per annum.
2. In addition to the salary provided for in Section 1:
 - (a) The Mayor shall be paid a sum of \$366.
 - (b) Each Councillor shall be paid a sum of \$216 per annum as allowances for expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as Mayor and councillors within the Village of McAdam.
3. The salaries and allowances provided for in third By-law shall be paid quarterly in equal instalments provided, however, that if the Mayor or any Councillor is absent from a regular meeting of the Council, the Village Treasurer shall deduct the sum of \$20 from the salary of each absentee unless such absentee is excused for reasonable cause by resolution of the Council.
