

MINUTES OF MEETING  
MCADAM VILLAGE COUNCIL  
AUGUST 29, 2019

A special meeting of the McAdam Village Council was held on Thursday, August 29, 2019 for the purpose of reading the by-law. Mayor Stannix presided and the following members were present;

Mayor Stannix called the meeting to order at 5:55 p.m.

The By-Law # 58 "A By-Law to Adopt the Village of McAdam Rural Plan" was circulated and reviewed. By-Law #58 was read in entirety. It was moved by Councillor Gallant and seconded by Councillor Little that:

"By-Law # 58, "A By-Law to Adopt the Village of McAdam Rural Plan" be accepted as read for the first time with changes to be made as discussed and request the view of the PRAC and set a date for a public meeting to be held after the views of PRAC are discussed." MOTION CARRIED.

By-Law #58 "A By-Law to Adopt the Village of McAdam Rural Plan" was read by title. It was moved by Councillor Robinson and seconded by Councillor Little that:

"By-Law #58 "A By-Law to Adopt the Village of McAdam Rural Plan" be approved as read by title for the second time." MOTION CARRIED.

Councillor Little inquired about the Animal Control By-Law and the final reading. It was agreed that we will inquire with RSC 10 regarding this by-law.

Purchase of Computer - Mayor Stannix advised council that a quote has been received from Bulletproof for a replacement computer for the Mayor's Office. The cost of replacement is \$1,600.00. After discussion it was moved by Councillor Little and seconded by Councillor Gallant that:

"The computer be purchased from Bulletproof at a cost of \$1,600.00." MOTION CARRIED.

The Business Plan has been received from Railside Coffee Shop which will be reviewed and discussed at the next meeting of council.

Councillor Robinson advised council that the Cross Country Meet will be held at the McAdam Campground again this year.

There being no further business, on motion of Councillor Robinson the meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
