

MINUTES OF MEETING – COVID 19 UPDATE

APRIL 22, 2020

A special meeting of the McAdam Village Council was held on April 22, 2020. Mayor Stannix presided and the following members were present:

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

CAO Arsenault update council on the recent updates as provided by Dr. Jennifer Russell today. At the present time there are no new cases, we are still at 118 cases. We have received additional PPE today.

A conference call was recently held with Dennis Blair regarding the St. Croix Beach. The outhouse and change rooms will be locked so that they are not usable. Garbage collection will begin on June 1, 2020. A sign has been ordered “Beach Closed” which will be installed shortly. A watercourse alteration permit will be applied for soon. We will try and have the St. Croix Waterway Commission invoice us monthly for cleaning and garbage removal at St. Croix Beach.

A meeting was held with Crandall Engineering, Mayor Stannix, Councillor Gallant and CAO Arsenault to review the next phase of the campground project. Council was advised that the pumps at the pumphouse should handle the next 9 lots and the comfort station. We will get further information from Crandall prior to the MEDC meeting.

The flower boxes have been ordered by Scott’s Nursery and we will need to make a few

additional boxes. Councillor Little advised council that he will make a few additional boxes.

Water Wells - A meeting will be held soon to discuss this project.

Caboose - The caboose is going to need some work done soon. Mayor Stannix advised council that new funding is available which will be reviewed by Councillor Gallant.

The storm drain on Harvey Road needs to be cleaned out. After discussion it was agreed that tenders would be received and reviewed.

Councillor Little advised council that the manhole on Saunders Road near the manor needs repair. CAO Arsenault advised council that it is on the list of work to be done.

Sidewalk Replacement - Mayor Stannix advised council that paving on Elm Street will be done this year and we will probably finish the Rose Street and Lake Avenue sidewalks that were started last year.

Councillor Gallant advised council that the camper would be in the trailer park until fall or until the campground opens.

Social distancing - The RCMP will be giving out warnings first and second offences will be a fine.

Sharps in the garbage - Mayor Stannix advised council that containers are available at the Health Centre and used sharps can also be dropped off at the Health Centre.

There being no further business, on motion of Councillor Swim, the meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
