There have been 6 interested parties in the Bakery, only 1 party has submitted a resume and a business plan. The application closes on Friday afternoon; this may be extended.

Mitchell – There will need to be some sidewalk repairs and roadwork completed in the future. There have been several complaints about sidewalk from Al's Place to the ambulance bay, the sidewalk from Frank Carroll's to Manny Nason's as well as the sidewalk along Saunders Road by Cook's Store.

Greg – no update

Jody – The McAdam High School is having issues with flagpole; the chain and pulley system needs to be replaced. The Village crew will take the manlift over so that it can be replaced.

The students working for the Village will be sweeping main street in the upcoming weeks. A blower will be purchased and could possibly be used for this as well.

The Village Crew has done a lot of repair work, cleaning, and maintenance to the treatment plant, and it is looking great.

Taylor – Attended a Zoom meeting on Economic issues working collectively. The meeting was positive, and Housing seemed to be the main issue. Although there was no resolve it was a very collaborative meeting.

Two Seed applications have been approved so far.
