Currently waiting for quotes for the parking lot across from Cooks store for curbing and paving. It should also be surveyed at the same time if possible.

Councillor Gallant – Picnic tables need to be put out soon around the Village.

The Hook and Paddle donation of \$750.00 will need to be sent in. Council approved the donation.

Mayor Stannix – There are dead Trees opposite the Lion's Club that need to be cleaned up. CAO Walsh will have this done.
