The regular monthly meeting of the McAdam Village Council was held in the Heritage Room of the McAdam Village Hall. Mayor Stannix presided, and the following members were present:

APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

Ambulance Services – Councillor Little will reach out to Ambulance New Brunswick to have a meeting regarding the lack of ambulance service in McAdam recently. The Fire Department has been called out to two calls recently that were over 40 minutes each to wait for an available ambulance.

NEW BUSINESS:

Canada Community Building Fund (CCBF) – After review, it was moved by Councillor Little and seconded by Councillor Gallant that:

“The document entitled *Agreement on the Canada Community-Building Fund with Local Governments (2024-2033) – Village of McADam* be adopted.” MOTION CARRIED.

McAdam Elementary School Playground Donation – After discussion it was moved by Councillor Little and Councillor Gallant that:

“\$10,000 be moved from the General Operating Reserve to the General Fund 22-17 for the playground donation to McAdam Elementary School”

Councillor Robinson – attended DECH Meeting and received an update. There is no imminent threat of closure, however there was no response as to why we moved on from 8th to 4th on the list. The catchment area for the bus zoning will be looked at in January, this may increase students to both schools.

CAO Walsh – Tree was removed at 17 Vanceboro Road. Paving is completed and sidewalks are finished. The last driveway for culvert installation was completed today.

At this time council went into Closed Meeting of Council to discuss a few items of business.

On the motion of Councillor Robinson, the meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
