

MINUTES OF MEETING
MCADAM VILLAGE COUNCIL

November 27, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the McAdam Village Council was held in the Heritage Room of the McAdam Village Hall. Mayor Stannix presided, and the following members were present:

APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

The agenda for the meeting was circulated and reviewed. It was moved by Councillor Swim and seconded by Councillor Robinson that:

“The agenda be approved as circulated.” MOTION CARRIED.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes of the Regular and Closed Meeting held on November 13, 2024, were circulated, and reviewed. It was moved by Councillor Gallant and seconded by Councillor Swim that:

“The minutes of the Regular and Closed Meeting held on November 13, 2024, be approved as circulated.” MOTION CARRIED.

OLD BUSINESS:

Letter to David Hickey re: Housing Properties – has been completed and submitted.

NEW BUSINESS:

EDSC Youth Employment – An application will be submitted for this job grant which runs from April until August and will pay 50% of the wage for a youth mentorship.

After discussion, it was moved by Councillor Robinson and seconded by Councillor Swim that:

“The amount of \$18752.80 be transferred from Dollar lot Trust Account [REDACTED] to General [REDACTED] to cover the cost of legal fees associated with the Dollar Lots.” MOTION CARRIED

It was moved by Councillor Little and seconded by Councillor Gallant that:

“Funds be transferred from the General Capital Reserve Investment fund to General Operating Account [REDACTED] for payment of The Owl’s Club building renovation up to the amount of invoice minus the tax \$36660.00.” MOTION CARRIED.

Panic Button – A panic button involves instant response from police. Will get quotes from Aliant and other companies.

Councillor Robinson – The Veterans flags need to be taken down this week or next and it will require one of the staff with the lift course. Councillor Robinson is unavailable as he is working right now.

The large Christmas tree needs to be decorated, Councillor Robinson and Councillor Gallant will do this on the weekend.

There is also footage that was done of the CPKC show. He will be donating the footage to the Village.

A thank you will be put out for the Christmas festivities.

Councillor Swim – Sidewalk machine looks good. It has been painted and fixed up. Burgundy Dodge is at Steven Watson’s for repair.

Councillor Gallant – The rebate for the heat pump upstairs has been submitted and there will also be an application for the garage door for treatment plant as well as for the insulation and windows/doors in Village Office

Mayor Stannix – No update

Councillor Little – The bus will need to have some body work done on the front where it had been hit and has never been repaired. Decals will also need to be put on the truck that has recently had bodywork completed.

There was a report that someone fell on the sidewalk between Harvey Road and Rose Street. It should be looked at to replace this portion of sidewalk.

First Aid courses – There is a new course offering through WCB however it requires the trainer to be registered under a company name. Council approved to Register councillor Little under the Village of McAdam for the WCB First Aid Course.

At this time council went into Closed Meeting of Council to discuss a few items of business.
