Kayak center completed and signs have been ordered; the old wharf still needs to be removed.

O’Keefe Infield needs new fill. Red dirt is \$21/tonne and would need to be picked up. Councillor Robinson get a quote for delivery.

The Hook and Paddle event was a success. Several participants booked sites at campground. The organization will be returning in August for a bass fishing event.

Concerns and complaints about walking trail. There are water issues and trees down. Dale Voutt has been contacted about cleanup for this year and has agreed to take care of this on an annual basis if the Village would like.
